Articulate 360 through OSU's Professional Development for Educators

Articulate 360 is a package of eLearning development applications. Articulate 360 includes:

- Storyline full-featured authoring tool that can be used to build custom, highly interactive modules
- Rise beginner-friendly eLearning authoring tool that allows users to build responsive online modules
- Content library stock images, audio, characters, templates and more
- Review Tool web-based platform for review and collaboration

Authoring tools have built-in features that allow users without programming skills to quickly and easily build interactive, online modules. Articulate Storyline and Rise are intuitive tools that are easy to get started with, yet have robust features that can be used to create complex modules. Never heard of Storyline? The <u>video</u> at the top of the linked page provides a great overview. And if you're wondering about Rise, check out that <u>intro video</u> as well.

We encourage you to explore Articulate 360 using the <u>free 30-day trial</u> before deciding if you would like to purchase a subscription.

Articulate Storyline and Rise software access is:

- Required for the Articulate Storyline and Rise course
- Optional for the eLearning Practicum and LXD Practicum courses; learners may choose to use Rise 360 or a Learning Management System (LMS) for the practicum project

Purchase Options

Articulate 360 requires a paid subscription. The full price for an individual subscription is \$1099/year. We are pleased to be able to offer discount options to learners enrolled in Professional Development for Educators (PDE) courses.

Annual subscription - \$549/year

Current enrollment in any PDE course qualifies you for Articulate's academic price of \$549/year, a 50% discount. Sign up for Articulate 360 <u>academic pricing</u>. You will be asked to confirm your academic status. Forwarding your OSU enrollment confirmation email will meet this requirement. Once activated, your Articulate 360 subscription will be good for 12-months; you do not need to maintain enrollment in OSU courses to retain the subscription.

Course duration – \$75 for duration of the course

Current enrollment in the Articulate Storyline and Rise course or a Practicum course qualifies you to access OSU's Articulate Teams account for the duration of the course. Please note that access is coordinated through your instructor, not directly with Articulate. Access instructions will be provided during the first week of class. You will have access to Articulate 360 until one week after the last day of the course. The module you create will remain online approximately two months following the close of the course. However, you won't be able to modify the module once your access to the Articulate Teams account ends.

FAQs

What if I already have an Articulate 360 subscription?

If you already have a Teams account through your employer or organization, you are welcome to use it for Professional Development for Educators (PDE) courses. If you have a full-price individual subscription, you can contact Articulate's customer service to request academic pricing.

What if I already have an academic discount?

Only one academic discount can be applied. Academic pricing through OSU will not reduce your price further.

Can I use the free 30-day trial for Professional Development for Educators (PDE) courses?

Generally, the <u>free 30-day trial</u> is not long enough to complete the requirements for PDE courses. However, if you are very motivated and can invest significant time during the 30-days of the free trial, instructors will work with you to adapt the course timelines to fit within the free trial. If you wish to do this, let your instructor know your plan and be prepared to spend 10+ hours/week on coursework during the free trial period.

Which courses qualify for Articulate's academic pricing?

Any Professional Development for Educators (PDE) course qualifies you for Articulate's academic pricing. This includes the eLearning certificate courses, LXD certificate courses, Visual Design for eLearning and Articulate Storyline and Rise.
