The chicks will be kept in a chicken coop

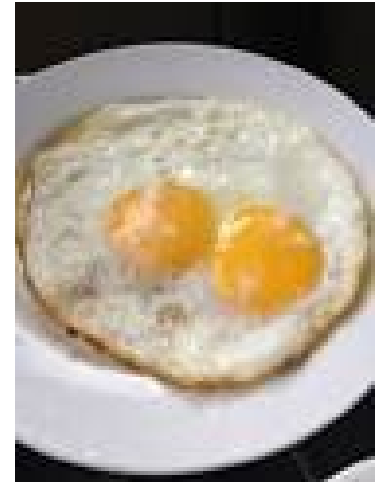


When the chicks are about 6 months old they will start laying eggs.
